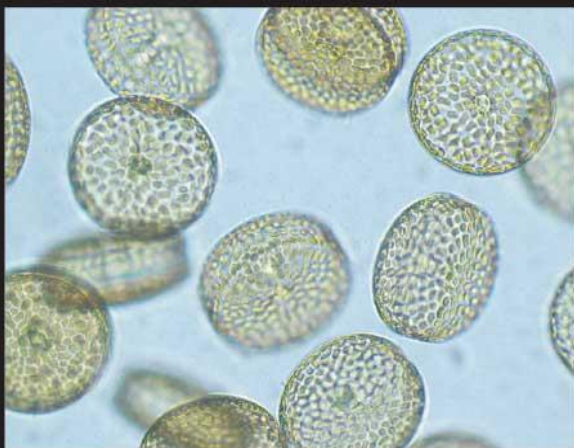


# Algal Biodiversity

The main focus of the course will be diatoms and seaweeds, but several other groups will be covered as well. - sampling and isolation techniques
- strain preservation techniques
- molecular and morphological strain characterization
- preparation of various culture media
- cell and life cycle characterisation and control
- ecophysiology
